24.01 ESTABLISHMENT; COMPOSITION. A Board of Park and Recreation Commissioners is established, which Board shall be composed of five (5) members who are residents of the City.

24.02 ELECTION; TERM. Commissioners shall be elected for a term of four (4) years.

24.03 COMPENSATION. The members of the Board shall receive compensation of seventy dollars (\$70.00) annually.

24.04 POWERS AND DUTIES GENERALLY. The Board of Park and Recreation Commissioners shall have exclusive control of the parks, recreational programs, and swimming pool of the City, and shall manage, improve and supervise the same. The Board may use the Park and Recreation Fund for improving the parks or for purchasing additional grounds or laying out and improving avenues thereto. Generally, the Board of Park and Recreation Commissioners may do all things necessary to preserve the parks, swimming pool and leisure time activities of all the City's residents. The Board shall not have the power to hire, fire or discipline employees.

24.05 DISBURSEMENTS. The Park and Recreation Fund revenues and expenditures shall be reported by the Clerk in the manner of other departmental revenues and expenditures and a copy shall be provided to each member of the Board and in the Clerk's report to the Council.

24.06 PARK POLICE OFFICERS. The Board of Park and Recreation Commissioners may appoint one or more park police officers and pay the park police officers out of the Park and Recreation Fund.
