GENERAL BUSINESS

1. **FY2015-2016 Budget**

a. Mayor Newgaard opened the public hearing on the adoption of the FY2015-2016 Budget. There were no oral or written comments. Mayor Newgaard closed the public hearing.

b. Nissly moved and Thies seconded to approve Resolution No. 2015-09 adopting the FY2015-2016 City of Iowa Falls Budget and certifying taxes.

2. **Sale of City Owned Property**

a. Mayor Newgaard opened the public hearing on the sale of property to Peter and Marian Gehrls. There were no oral or written comments. Mayor Newgaard closed the public hearing.

b. Thies moved and Messa seconded to approve Resolution No. 2015-10 approving the sale of city property consisting of real property identified as Lot 8, Block 4 Bliss Riverside Park Addition.

3. **Rocksylvania Avenue Culvert Rehabilitation**

Nissly moved and Thies seconded to approve Resolution No. 2015-11 accepting the Engineer's Statement of Completion and Final Acceptance of Work for the Rocksylvania Avenue Culvert Rehabilitation.
Roll Vote: Nissly, Thies, Davidson and Messa voting aye.

4. **Revolving Loan Fund Loan**

This moved and Nissly seconded to approve a Revolving Loan Fund Loan to Iowa Falls Area Development Corporation in the amount of \$39,800 with repayment over a five year period.

ADJOURNMENT


This moved and Nissly seconded to adjourn.
