ACCEPTANCE OF THE AGENDA

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. **Sale of Property**

a. Mayor Newgaard opened the public hearing on the sale of 210 E Main Street to Brian Pieper and Randy Brown. There were no oral or written comments. Mayor Newgaard closed the public hearing.

b. Davidson moved and Nissly seconded to approve Resolution No. 2017-32 approving the sale of 210 E Main Street to Brian Pieper and Randy Brown in the amount of \$6,300.

2. **Iowa Department of Public Safety**

Thies moved and Nissly seconded to approve the Memorandum of Agreement with the Iowa Department of Public Safety for the placement of a new tower for use in the Iowa Statewide Interoperable Communications System to be located at 2024 River Road.

3. **Iowa Falls Airport**

Nissly moved and Davidson seconded to approve Resolution No. 2017-33 approving submittal of an application for an Iowa DOT Airport Funding Grant, subject to getting the grant and the Council determining the funding source at a later date.

4. **Parks & Rec Department**

Thies moved and Davidson seconded to approve the CIP items for the Parks & Rec Department including a truck, mower, roof repairs and various replacement and repair parts for the Meyer Municipal Aquatic Center.


Roll Vote: Thies, Davidson and Nissly voting aye.
