ACCEPTANCE OF THE AGENDA

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. <u>Urban Renewal Plan</u>

Nissly moved and Wohlert seconded to approve Resolution No. 2015-61 setting dates of a consultation and a public hearing on a proposed Amendment No. 13 to the Iowa Falls Urban Renewal Plan in the City of Iowa Falls, State of Iowa.

2. Ellsworth Neighborhood Development Urban Renewal Plan

a. Messa moved and Wohlert seconded to approve Resolution No. 2015-62 determining the necessity and setting dates of a consultation and a public hearing on a proposed Ellsworth Neighborhood Development Urban Renewal Plan for a proposed Urban Renewal Area in the City of Iowa Falls, State of Iowa.

b. Nissly moved and Wohlert seconded to approve Resolution No. 2015-63 (1) approving the minimum development requirements, competitive criteria, and procedures for disposition of certain property located within the Ellsworth Neighborhood Development Urban Renewal Area; (2) determining that the proposal submitted by Ellsworth Neighborhood Investment Group, LLC satisfies the offering requirements and declaring the intent of the City to enter into a Development Agreement by and between the City of Iowa Falls, Iowa and Ellsworth Neighborhood Investment Group, LLC ("Developer"), in the event that no competing proposals are submitted; and (3) soliciting completing proposals.

c. Wohlert moved and Thies seconded to approve Resolution No. 2015-64 fixing date for a public hearing on the proposal to enter into a Development Agreement with Ellsworth Neighborhood Investment Group, LLC, and providing for publication of notice thereof.

3. Streetscape Project

4. Cedar Street Lift Station Rehabilitation

5. Arbitrage Rebate Services

6. Municipal Code Update

a. Thies moved and Nissly seconded to approve on first reading an Ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Iowa Falls, Iowa, by repealing provisions pertaining to railroad warning signals.

b. Messa moved and Wohlert seconded to suspend the rules and place on third and final reading.

c. Thies moved and Nissly seconded to approve on third and final reading Ordinance No. 1068 amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Iowa Falls, Iowa, by repealing provisions pertaining to railroad warning signals.
