Hackberry	<i>CELTIS OCCIDENTALIS</i>	
Honeylocust	<i>GLEDITSIA TRIACANTHOS</i>	THORNLESS CULTIVARS ONLY
White Oak	<i>QUERCUS ALBA</i>	SUSCEPTIBLE TO OAK WILT
Swamp White Oak	<i>QUERCUS BICOLOR</i>	
Bur Oak	<i>QUERCUS MACROCARPA</i>	SUSCEPTIBLE TO OAK WILT
Northern Red Oak	<i>QUERCUS RUBRA</i>	VERY SUSCEPTIBLE TO OAK WILT
Silver Linden‡	<i>TILIA TOMENTOSA</i>	SENSITIVE TO DEICING SALT
Redmond Linden	<i>TILIA AMERICAN 'Redmond'</i>	SENSITIVE TO DEICING SALT
Littleleaf Linden‡	<i>TILIA CORDATA</i>	SENSITIVE TO DEICING SALT
Black Gum	<i>NYSSA SYLVATICA</i>	ALSO CALLED BLACK TUPELO

Eastern Redbud	<i>CERCIS CANADENSIS</i>	
Green Hawthorn	<i>CRATAEGUS VIRIDIS</i>	THORNLESS VARIETIES ONLY
Washington Hawthorn	<i>CRATAEGUS PHAENOPYRUM</i>	THORNLESS VARIETIES ONLY
Crabapple	<i>MALUS</i>	DISEASE RESISTANT VARIETIES ONLY, SUCH AS ADIRONDACK, IVORY SPEAR, ...
American Hophornbeam	<i>OSTRYA VIRGINANA</i>	ALSO CALLED IRONWOOD AND HOP HORNBEAM
Sargent Cherry‡	<i>PRUNUS SARGENTI</i>	
American Hornbeam	<i>CARPINUS CAROLINIANA</i>	ALSO CALLED BLUE BEECH AND MUSCLEWOOD
Amur Maackia‡	<i>MAACKIA AMURENSIS</i>	SUSCEPTIBLE TO OAK WILT
Japanese Lilac Tree‡	<i>SYRINGA RETICULATA</i>	INCLUDING PEKINENSIS SUBSPECIES
