Weekly Overview: September 25th – September 29th

- Kingston sawcut and sealed joints and opened the road on Wednesday evening.
- The process of removing temporary surfacing was begun.

What to expect next week: October 2nd – October 6th

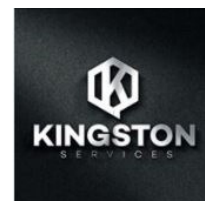
Monday-Friday

- Intake tops will be placed.
- Paint striping will be placed.
- Site will be cleaned up.
- Site will be seeded.

What you need to know

- During sawcutting and cleaning, there will be dust generated.
- Phase 1 traffic (west half of Brooks Road) is open to local traffic.
- Phase 2 traffic (east half of Brooks Road) should find alternative ways to access property. Traffic on the portion of Brooks Road being constructed is NOT allowed. Please utilize signage to determine what areas are open/closed.
- GARBAGE/RECYCLING PICK-UP –
 - Please put garbage/recycling out as you normally do.
