160.01 CODE ADOPTED. The *International Mechanical Code*, 2015 Edition, published by the International Code Council, and the appendices and the installation standards thereto are adopted by reference as the Mechanical Code for the City.

160.02 OFFICIAL DESIGNATED. The Building Official under the Mechanical Code shall be the Director of Building and Zoning or designee.

160.03 DEFINITIONS. For use in this chapter, the following terms are defined:

- 1. "Apprentice" means a person who has worked under the direct supervision of a mechanical contractor or a mechanical journeyman in performing actual mechanical work subject to the direct supervision of a licensed mechanical contractor or journeyman.
- 2. "Mechanical contractor" means any person, firm, corporation, association, or combination thereof, who or which undertakes or offers to undertake to plan for, lay out, supervise, and do mechanical work for a fixed sum, price, fee, percentage, or other compensation.
- 3. "Mechanical journeyman" means a person who has the necessary qualifications, training, experience and technical knowledge to do mechanical work in accordance with the standard rules and regulations governing such work and the Uniform Mechanical Code and appendices referred to in Section 160.01 of this chapter.
- **160.04 LICENSE REQUIRED.** It is unlawful for any person to engage in the mechanical business as a mechanical contractor in the City without having first shown proof to the City of Iowa Falls that they have a current mechanical license issued by the State of Iowa. No person other than a licensed mechanical contractor may carry on or be engaged in the mechanical business. No mechanical contractor shall employ for mechanical work any but mechanical journeyman licensed by the State of Iowa.

160.05 EXCEPTION. An apprentice employed to assist a licensed mechanical contractor or mechanical journeyman need not be licensed. However, such apprentices shall perform no work which is not under the direct supervision of a licensed mechanical journeyman.
