12. **Housing Grant**

a. Mayor Welden opened the public hearing on the submittal of an application to the Iowa Department of Economic Development Housing Fund for a \$360,000 Grant for improving at least ten owner occupied structures within Iowa Falls. Donna Sampson with Region 6 Planning Commission explained that the application would be for a \$329,990 Iowa Department of Economic Development Housing Fund application for improving at least ten owner occupied structures within Iowa Falls. There were three applicants from the phase II project that could not be assisted. There are more than 25 interested pre-applicants on file. This phase III project will assist with meeting the needs contained in the 1996 Housing Study. The proposed project will be funded through a \$329,990 CDBG application and \$30,000 of City funds. The CDBG application will be submitted on November 13, 2009. The City will hear whether the project is funded in April of 2010. If the project is selected for funding, applications will be accepted in early summer 2010 and the work will continue through March 2012. All the funds will benefit persons of low and moderate incomes. The proposed project will be done in the Central Target Neighborhood which is generally north of the Iowa River and west of Ellsworth Municipal Hospital. Nobody will be displaced with the project.

The work will include rehabilitation of owner occupied structures. There were no further oral or written comments. Mayor Welden closed the public hearing.

b. Messa moved and Thies seconded to approve Resolution No. 2009-49 to approve the Iowa Falls Housing rehabilitation application to the Iowa Department of Economic Development Housing Fund.
