Programs

The classes and programs listed are designed to fit the leisure time needs of the community. The department attempts to organize special classes if facilities and qualified instructors are available. *If you or someone you know would like to teach or have a suggestion for a new class or program, please give us a call.* Waiting lists will be established for programs reaching their enrollment capacity. We reserve the right to change dates and times on any of the programs as may be necessary.

Cancellations

Programs that are cancelled due to weather conditions, equipment malfunctions, or other unforeseen circumstances beyond our control will be announced on Facebook, KIFG radio and signs will be posted at the site. Where youth are involved, parents are asked to pick up their children from the program site as soon as possible when threatening weather conditions occur.

Registration

All programs have a registration deadline. Late registration fees will be billed an additional charge. No telephone registrations will be accepted. All registrations are taken on a first come, first serve basis. All fees are payable at the time of registration. Registration can be conducted at the Park & Rec office at City Hall, 901 Washington. Registration forms will be distributed at the schools in the Wednesday packet.

Refund Policy

Refunds will be given at the discretion of the Parks and Recreation Department with 25% being withheld for administrative costs with a \$5.00 minimum.

YOUTH ACTIVITIES:



Little Goal Kickers

Citizens, groups or organizations are welcome to adopt a neighborhood or favorite park area and become involved in the protection, maintenance and development of your city's outdoor recreation resources. Possible activities include participation in park improvements, cleanup or simply taking an active interest in the condition and future of a favorite or neighborhood park facility. Garden Plots

The Iowa Falls Park and Rec Department will be offering garden plots at the Park Shop located on Highway 65 South. Lot sizes will range from 15' x 20', 15' x 40' and larger if requested. The sites will be tilled and ready for planting. Water will be available. Fees for these plots will be \$25 for the 15' x 20' area, \$50 for the 15' x 40' area and fees for the larger areas will be determined at the time the area size is established.

Parks

Estes Park established October 14, 1890, is located at 610 Estes Street, it features a bandshell, fountain, playground and a life-size statue of Bill Riley.

Ellsworth Park was established in 1897 and is located at 100 Park Avenue on the Iowa River.

Linear Park was established in part on February 5, 1898, and the remainder on December 27, 1912 and is located along Foster Boulevard and Park Avenue.

Oak Park established November 24, 1902, is located at 200 Park Avenue. This park features a basketball court and a large playground.

Jones Park established June 11, 1926, is located at 101 East Rocksylvania Avenue. The Meyer Municipal Aquatic Center is located in this park.

Rock Run Park established September 22, 1934, is located on Rocksylvania Avenue.

Foster Park established April 23, 1935, is located at 812 Dale Drive along the Iowa River. Foster Park features two shelters that can be reserved, a fishing dock and a Disc Golf Course which was established in 2008.

Dougan's Landing was established June 8, 1953, and is located at 120 South River Street.

North Park was established May 18, 1963, and is located at 810 Woodland Avenue. The park features a gazebo and a shelter.

Fitz Riverbend Park was established December 27, 1963, and is located at 724 Cedar Street.

Assembly Park established April 22, 1969, is located at 122 Mildred Avenue on the Iowa River. The park features reservable shelters, playground, tennis and basketball courts, walking trains and the Swinging Bridge.

Sunnyside Park established October 27, 1975, is located at 342 South Oak Street. This is the location of the dog park which was established in 2013.

Legion Field has been leased from the American Legion Hyman-Peavy Post #188 since September 30, 1978, and is located at 3021 Washington Avenue. Legion Field offers two baseball/softball diamonds and a playground.

West Side Rest Area was established June 22, 1983, and is located on Washington Avenue.

Julia O'Neil Park established July 4, 1984, is located at 905 East Rocksylvania Avenue. The park features a shelter that can be reserved, a basketball court and a large playground area.

Weaver's Cove was established August 6, 1990, and is located at 2623 River Road. The park features river access and a boat ramp.

Paradise Park, the site of a skate park, was established April 18, 2005, and is located at 213 South River Street.

Park Shelter Reservations

The park shelters located throughout the various parks in the city are available for your company picnics or weekend outings. Contact City Hall at 648-2527 for further information on reserving a park shelter. Reservation fees are as follows: \$15.00 for Julia O'Neil, Assembly North and Foster North, \$20.00 for Assembly South Shelter and Foster South Shelter.

Iowa Falls Tree Board

The Iowa Falls Community Tree Board was established June 24, 1991, to provide the community assistance in areas of planning, planting and care. The Tree Board uses a city ordinance and a keen interest in the community canopy to help all maintain a beautiful safe community. Permits are available at City Hall and there is no fee for permission to plant or remove trees in the parking area along our city streets. Our interests are the proper tree in the proper place, and what you intend for the future.
