2. **CDBG Housing Grants**

Klein moved and Gritsch seconded to set a public hearing for the July 19, 2021 City Council meeting to review a \$210,000 Iowa Economic Development Authority Housing Sustainability application to improve 6 city wide qualified owner occupied housing units.
