

**CITY OF IOWA FALLS
SPECIAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 3, 2022**

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Iowa Falls met in special session on Thursday, November 3, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Michael R. Emerson presiding over the meeting. Council Members Micah Cutler, Michelle Gritsch, Steve Klein, Roger Nissly and Bruce Thies were present. Also present was City Manager Jody Anderson.

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AGENDA

Cutler moved and Thies seconded to accept the agenda as written.
Vote: Cutler, Thies, Nissly, Klein and Gritsch voting aye.

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. **Dispatch Services**

The Mayor and Council reviewed and answered questions from the fire fighters and general public.

2. **Sidewalk Removal**

Nissly moved and Klein seconded to deny the request from Scott Danger to remove the sidewalk at 809 Fremont and 404 Union.
Roll Vote: Nissly, Klein, Gritsch, Cutler and Thies voting aye.

3. **Tuckpointing of City Buildings**

Klein moved and Gritsch seconded to approve the bid from Vinton Tuckpointing Inc. for tuckpointing the Police Department building, old City Hall building and the Carnegie building with the funds for the Carnegie building coming from previously approved funds and the Schiller grant and the additional funds coming from 80% LOST, AND Fund 78 Building Maintenance, with the total cost being \$155,473.
Roll Vote: Klein, Gritsch, Thies, Cutler and Nissly voting aye.

4. **Handicap Parking Space**

Thies moved and Nissly seconded to approve Resolution No. 2022-73 providing a handicap parking space in the 500 block of Washington on the south side of the street, at the east, in front of 503 Washington.
Roll Vote: Thies, Nissly, Klein, Gritsch and Cutler voting aye.

5. **Closed Session**

Nissly moved and Thies seconded to go into closed session as allowed in Iowa Code Section 21.5.1.j to discuss land acquisition and disposal.

Roll Vote: Nissly, Thies, Cutler, Klein and Gritsch voting aye.

Thies moved and Cutler seconded to go back into open session having taken no action in closed session.

Roll Vote: Thies, Cutler, Nissly, Klein and Gritsch voting aye.

Thies moved and Cutler seconded to adjourn.

Vote: Thies, Cutler, Nissly, Klein and Gritsch voting aye.
