CITY OF IOWA FALLS REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING APRIL 17, 2023

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Iowa Falls met in regular session on Monday, April 17, 2023 with Mayor Michael R. Emerson presiding over the meeting. Council Members Micah Cutler, Michelle Gritsch, Steve Klein, and Bruce Thies were present. Council Member Roger Nissly was absent. Also present was City Manager Jody Anderson.

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AGENDA

Thies moved and Cutler seconded to accept the agenda with the removal of Item #8 Fire Department.

Klein moved and Gritsch seconded to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of March 20, 2023.

7. Wastewater Treatment Department

9. **2023 Street Improvements**

Klein moved and Cutler second to go out for bids the 2023 Street Improvements, using funds from Road Use Tax, 80% LOST and the General Fund.

10. **Discount Garbage Tag Program**

Klein moved and Thies seconded to authorize staff to use the following funding sources: Water Bonds, Wastewater Bonds, GO Bonds, State and Federal Grants, American Rescue Plan Act Funds, Water and Wastewater Cash, sewer Improvement Funds, Local Option Sales Taxes – 80% and 20% as allowed by the referendum, loans from the Revolving Loan Fund and Residential TIF for the following projects: Elk Run Bridge, Palisades Developments, River Road Improvements, Weaver's Cove Well and various test wells, Heritage Estates Development and other City improvement projects.
