

Union Street Water Main Improvements

Weekly Construction Update



The intent of this weekly update is to give an overview of where construction has been, and where it should be in the next week. It is intended to be a general overview and be tentative in nature. Things may differ from the listed schedule if weather or other unknown factors come into play.

Weekly Overview: August 19th – August 23rd

- This week, King paved the intersection of Cedar Street (north) and Union and the intersection of River Street and Union.
- King also poured the ADA ramps at River Street and Union.
- Wednesday, Heartland Asphalt paved the intermediate course on Union.
- Thursday, Heartland Asphalt paved the surface course on Union.
- Gehrke removed the old hydrant at the end of Riverview Drive.
- Gehrke also has been working on the Riverbend Middle School driveway improvements.

- Gehrke will work on Saturday, August 24th to make progress on the project. Also, roadway sealant will be placed in the concrete joints between Cedar Street (south) and Cedar Street (north) along Union.

What to expect next week: August 26th – August 30th

Monday-Friday

- Gehrke will continue working on the driveway for the middle school.
- Curb and gutter will be installed along the Riverview cul-de-sac and along Union at the west end of Union.

What you need to know

- Traffic will be restricted on Saturday, August 24th while sealant is being placed on Union Street.
- Traffic along Union will be open from River to the west driveway of the middle school loop driveway on Monday.
- Please utilize construction signage to know what is closed and what is open and which way to drive. Vehicular traffic should use other routes of access during this time. Pedestrian traffic should use caution in construction areas. Please also obey personnel who are directing traffic during construction to help keep everyone safe.
- GARBAGE/RECYCLING PICK-UP –
 - Please put garbage and recycling out as you would normally, however, please use bags to allow sanitation crews better ability to pick up garbage in the construction zones.
- At this time, it is planned the post office will continue to deliver mail to your residence unless you live along Riverview Drive, where temporary mailboxes will be placed at Union/Riverview intersection.
